has a large collection of 4,000 different plants over thirty acres. Throughout the grounds there almost thirty different gardens, landscapes, and two natural areas.

Some highlights are the Waterfall in the Tropical Rain Forest, the Bamboo Garden, and the Desert Gardens. Be sure to see the new Undersea Garden and the Landscape for Fire Safety, located by the Ecke Building. Nearby is the miniature railroad, located at the “Seeds of Wonder” children’s garden. Another new feature is California Gardenscapes, our native California plant garden.
